Bea Miller Proves Her Concert Special Is a Must-Watch with This New Video

The up-and-comer offers a sneak peek of her live show.



Pop starlet Bea Miller teases her upcoming concert TV special with a lively performance of her track, "S.L.U.T.," an upbeat anthem about rising above being shamed and embracing self-love.

The 18-year-old *The X Factor* alum was first inspired to write the tune after receiving backlash from an online commenter for freeing the nipple in a picture. "After she saw my photo, the girl called me a slut, and I lost it," the singer **recalled**. "I was ranting and raving. How could a girl tell another girl to wear a bra? Women should support each other....and I don't understand what the problem is with nipples."

After sifting through its the derogatory definitions on Urban Dictionary, Miller actually found an empowering acronym for the term: "Sweet Little Unforgettable Thing."

"I thought, that's amazing, and we wound up writing a fantastic song that was also a cool and funny response to this girl," she said.

The tongue-in-cheek single is set to appear on Miller's debut album, which she's gearing up to release this year. The singer worked on the project with Nick Jonas, pop power duo Julia Michaels and Justin Tranter (who co-wrote Justin Bieber's "Sorry," Selena Gomez's "Bad Liar," and more), Jesse Shatkin, Pop & Oak, and Ilsey.

The album will encompass songs she released in her trilogy of EPs dedicated to primary colors—*chapter one: blue*, inspired by the sadness of letting go of someone close to you, *chapter two: red*, about rebirth and starting again, and *chapter three: yellow*, about self-discovery. Miller just **dropped** the third installment in October 2017.
