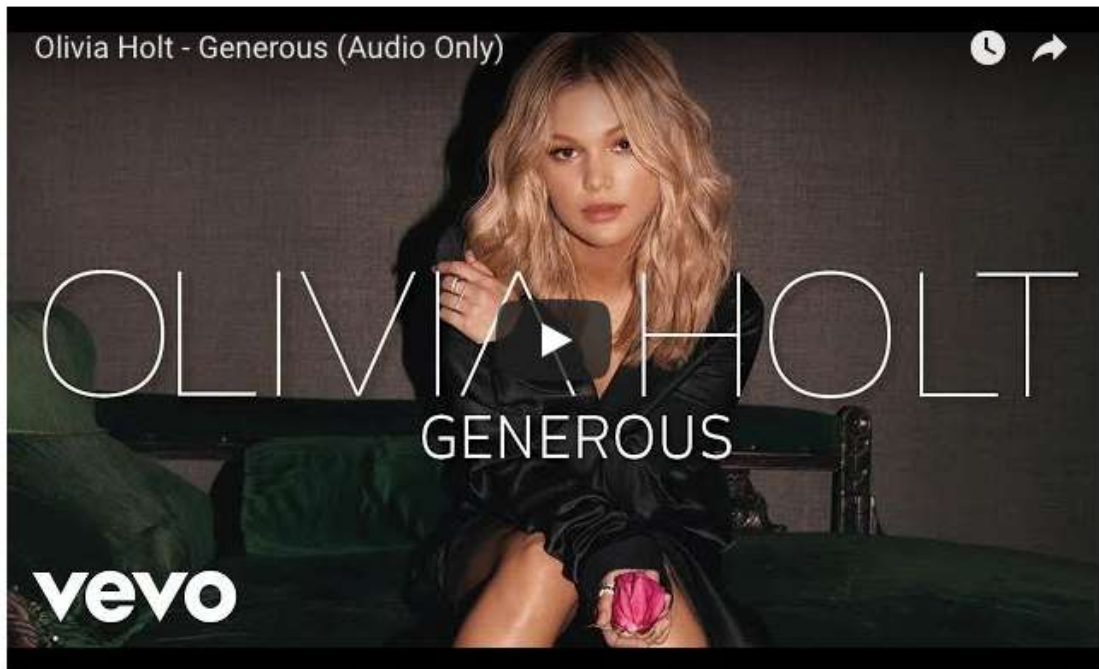


16 new music releases to supercharge your playlists
